Rescue Committee to save their building, demanding that GRE does not purchase the building.

Downtowner: in 2011, GRE purchased the Downtowner, a 240-unit building of affordable public housing. Tenants covered by the rent supplement contract organized to win housing choice Section 8 vouchers. Goodman Real Estate used low-income housing tax credits to rehabilitate the building, dubbed it the "Addison on Fourth," and raised the rents beyond the payment standard for tenants with vouchers. Only a handful of the original tenants at the Downtowner remain in their homes.
